



2025 - Come and Try Athletics Day

Dear Families,

The 2025 Come and Try Athletics event will be held at the track at **Narellan Sports Hub on Monday 10 March 2025**. This event is an opportunity for students to participate in both track and field events in a supportive and engaging environment.

Cost:

Students are required to pay an entry fee of \$5 to the front office.

Transport and Time:

Students must organise their own transport to and from Narellan Sports Hub. They are to meet Miss Aguilera upon arrival at **9:30am**. Students should arrive no later than 9:40am as the first event commenced at 10:00am. All activities will finish approximately by 2:00pm. Students must be signed out by a parent or carer once the event has finished.

Events:

Students will remain in school groups throughout the day. They will only be separated into age divisions for running events. The event is structured as follows:

- **Morning session:** Track events (50m, 100m, 200m, and relays)
- **Afternoon session:** Field event rotations (long jump, shot put, discus, javelin)

Students must stay within the designated areas at all times to ensure their safety and supervision. As this is a participation-based event, spectators are not encouraged.

Food and Drink:

Students should bring their own food and drink, as no canteen facilities will be available.

Clothing:

Students must wear full school uniform and appropriate closed-in footwear. They must also bring a school hat and a water bottle to participate in events. If your child has asthma, they must carry their inhaler with them.

Accident insurance information

In the event of injury, no accident or medical insurance cover is provided by the NSW Government Treasury Managed Fund for students participating in school sporting activities, physical education lessons or any other school endorsed activity, unless there is a breach of duty of care by department or school staff. The NSW Department of Education is insured to meet the financial impact of any legal liabilities arising from its activities. It does not provide, nor has it ever provided, accident or medical insurance for students enrolled in government schools.

Concussion management

When a student enrolled in a government school is diagnosed with concussion, the principal must be advised in writing as soon as the diagnosis is confirmed. Students may only return to sport and physical activity once a medical clearance has been provided to the school and, if at a school sport event, to the supervising teacher. Any student that experiences a suspected concussion during a school endorsed activity, will be removed from the activity and parents/carers will be advised that a medical follow-up is required. If medical clearance is not provided, the student cannot participate in vigorous or competitive school sport or physical activities for 21 days from the concussion date.

Children will NOT be able to participate in any activities, unless this completed note is returned.
