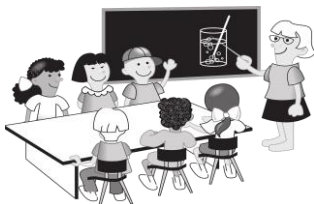
### Parking & Safety Issues
