Eschol Park Indigenous Design School Shirts

During 2021, our school approached Dreamtime Sporting and Corporate Apparel to design an Indigenous shirt for EPPS. Our First Nation families and students voted on the designs offered based on aspects such as colours and story and we are proud to show you the chosen design by artist Josh Sly.



While we did an initial order for our First Nation students, who you may have seen proudly wearing these shirts already, the shirt is actually available for all students of EPPS to purchase, if they wish. There is no expectation to buy. If you are interested in purchasing a shirt for your child/ren, please collect an order form from the school office. The cost is **\$45** per shirt. There is a size guide on the order form, but there are some shirts available at school for students to try on to help determine their size. Orders close on Thursday, 10th March, 2022 as we would like them to be available at the start of Term 2 and production and delivery takes 6 weeks.

COVID INFORMATION

The information comes through to my email at various times and days. When I have information to update the community I will do so in the newsletter if it is in line with the day we send it out or through the skoolbag app, facebook or parent emails.

Restrictions on adults visiting the school site are still in place. If you need to pick up your child early for a genuine appointment, please notify the office staff before time then ring them from the school gate when you arrive. Children will be escorted to you at the front gate.

Kindergarten parents are permitted on site to drop off (and leave quickly) and pick up their children in the afternoon. Please wait on the grass in front of the ramp as it is easy for the teachers to see you and allow your child to come to you.

RAT KITS

Your child will bring home 4 RAT Kits on Thursday 10 February to use for the next two weeks of Monday/Wednesday testing. Please do not leave these kits in your child's bag. Take them out as soon as they get home and store in a cool place.

If a student or staff member receives a positive RAT result, they need to:

- record the positive RAT result through the [Service NSW website](#)External link or [Service NSW app](#)External link
- notify the school of the positive RAT or PCR result as soon as possible
- follow [NSW Health advice](#)External link to isolate for 7 days.

Negative results do not need to be reported to Service NSW or to the school.
