COVID UPDATE

From **Monday 28 February**, schools and early childhood education can invite visitors – including parents, carers and families – to their sites regardless of their vaccination status, in line with settings in the broader community.

All visitors (parents and carers, volunteers and contractors including cleaners) must use the <u>School Visitor Check-in</u> to comply with school sign-in procedures.

Cohorting: From **Monday 28 February**, schools will no longer need to keep students in their class or year group cohorts. This means schools can remove staggered start and finish times (does not affect us) and reintroduce crossyear group activities and events.

From **Monday 7 March**, masks will no longer be mandatory for staff in primary schools and early childhood settings. This staggered change recognises the lower vaccination rates in primary school-aged students.

Hygiene and cleaning: Students and staff are encouraged to wash or sanitise their hands regularly. Schools will continue to use enhanced cleaning processes. Target areas include high-touch areas, hard surfaces, door handles, lockers, light switches and handrails in stairways and areas where students and staff move through regularly.

Staff and students cannot attend school if they are showing any symptoms of COVID-19External link.

If symptoms occur at any time, your child should not attend school and should undertake a rapid antigen test.

From Monday 28 February, schools will align with community settings of 'symptomatic testing' and the department will provide:

- 8 tests per student and staff in schools
- Students and staff can use their allocation of RATs at their discretion such as if they are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms.

COVID continued

Students and staff can use their allocation of RATs at their discretion such as if they are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms.

If your child has even mild COVID-19 symptoms, get them tested with a RAT or PCR (nose and throat swab) test.

They must isolate until they receive a negative test result, in line with health protocols.

If symptoms continue, they should stay at home and take another RAT in 24 hours or have a PCR test. If the second RAT or initial PCR test result is negative, or another diagnosis is confirmed such as hay fever, they can return to school.

It is recommended that staff and students who return to school after recovering from COVID-19 do not participate in rapid antigen test surveillance for 28 days (4 weeks after recovery) following release from self-isolation. This is due to NSW Health advice that people who have recovered from COVID-19 have a low risk of contracting it again in the following 28 days. After 28 days (from week 5 after recovery), staff and students may resume participation in RAT surveillance.
