Lock Down and Evacuation Drills

As part of our Duty of Care, we will be undertaking practise of emergency procedures between Week 8 and Week 10 weather permitting. When a practice drill has been scheduled, teachers will take the time to explain to students the warning signs that will be given and what will be happening. Following a drill, staff will take the opportunity to discuss any issues. The practice drills ensure that staff and students understand what they would be expected to do in an emergency situation.

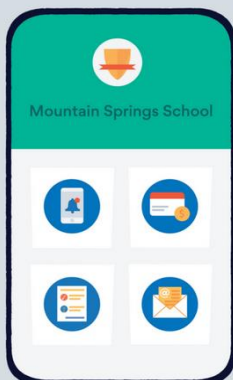
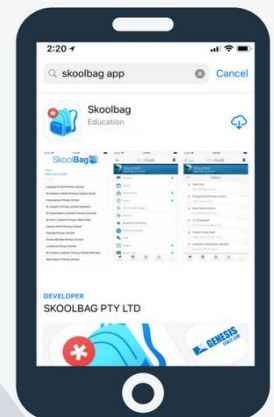
