### Eschol Park Public School Colour Run!

Dear Families,

On Friday 8 September, Stage Three will be hosting a K-6 Colour Run event as a part of their fundraising efforts.

This event will be held at approximately 1:45pm on the oval. The colour powder is made from 98% corn starch and 2% permitted colours, making it non-toxic and biodegradable.

The powder will be aimed towards the torso and sunglasses will be provided for students on the day.

Cost: The cost of the Colour Run is \$15. A pair of sunglasses for each student is included in this cost.

What to wear: Students are encouraged to wear white clothing on the day with enclosed footwear. Long sleeved shirts are preferrable.

#### \*Please note that the powder used as part of the colour run can be difficult to remove from clothing\*

It is advised that you cover any car seats that the students will be sitting on with plastic or an old towel when travelling home. If you want to keep the colour in your t-shirt, spray with vinegar. However, the colour powder will wash out after several washes.

Families are welcome to attend, although please ensure you remain on the outside of the fenced area.


